

## La Cabeza de Perro Blanco 2020

Vintage: 2020

Grape Varieties: 60% Palomino, 40% Doña Blanca DO Bierzo white wine, old vineyards in Villalibre Orientation: East and North, Elevation: 550-600m

Soils: clay with stones and clay Harvest date: 13<sup>th</sup> September 2020

Production: 2,400 bottles

Alcohol: 14.0%

**Tasting Notes:** Shinny golden colour. On the nose it is a very fruity wine, with aromas of stone fruits such as apricot and apples. In the mouth it is elegant and bodied with a high gastronomic profile. Ideal to be shared on a table around a nice meal.

La Cabeza de Perro is a wine meant to be shared and enjoyed, that last in the glass time enough for conversation leading to ask for a refill. It is a traditional Bierzo white wine combining the most cultivated white varieties on very old vineyards from the Southeast part of Bierzo, that enjoys a fresher climate and receives less sun radiation.

Harvested mid September, grapes are picked manually and sent to the winery in 15Kg cases where it is pressed and after decanting the solids is put to ferment spontaneously by its natural yeasts in a French oak vat. After completing alcoholic fermentation it is put to rest on its lees for 8 months in stell vats and oak casks. Bottled in June 2021.
